

**AN ACT CONCERNING TRANSGENDER YOUTH**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1. Section 1: All transgender students who attend public schools in the state of
2. Connecticut shall be allowed to participate in recreational activities provided by
3. the school. A transgender student who identifies him/herself as a male or female
4. shall be allowed to participate in the identified recreational activity regardless
5. of their biological sex.

7. Section 2: A legal document from a psychologist, therapist, or legal personnel is
8. required by the student to clarify the student is transgender.
- 9.
10. Section 3: All acts committed against transgender youth are urged to be documented
11. and reported to the superintendent.
- 12.
13. Section 4: Any directors, facilitators, coordinators, etc. who do not allow
14. transgender youth to participate in recreational activities shall be suspended from
15. work for 3 weeks without pay and will be required to take part in an L.G.B.T.
16. Awareness seminar.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
